

HOW TO BE A GREAT DISCIPLE MAKER:

- Spend time personally with Jesus every day
- Regularly talk with your group about the purpose of **Multiplying: making disciple who make disciples.**
- Complete all assignments in the manual for each session.
- Participate in group discussions by vulnerably sharing what the Lord is teaching you.
- Humbly maintain a perspective that you are not discipling the group members - you all are being disciplined by Jesus and the Holy Spirit. All group members will grow and hold each other accountable.
- Daily practice spiritual disciplines:
 - o Read Bible
 - o Pray
 - o Meditate on Scripture
 - o Be still with God
 - o Record your thoughts in a spiritual journal
 - o Memorize Scripture with your group

- Share leadership responsibility by occasionally asking group members to lead.
- Pray for your group members often and let them know when you do. Engage with them via phone calls, texting, emails, or social media.
- Balance time in discussions to give all members time to share. Stay aware of unproductive rabbit trails in discussions and redirect the group back on topic.

Optional redirection, “Great question and interesting discussion - can we have coffee this week and talk further about your question?”

- After completing your time together stay in touch with your group members. Connect monthly (coffee, meal, phone call), ask them accountability questions, visit the group they are leading through the manual for a few minutes of encouragement.
- Be willing to be vulnerable with your group by sharing your personal struggles and sins to confess one to another that led to your repentance.
